NO OVERWEIGHT ALLOWANCES

#### GENERAL RULES

- 1) TRACTORS MUST BE 1970 OR OLDER – NO TURBOS ALLOWED
- 2) MUST HAVE WORKING GOVERNOR (STOCK AND SEMI-STOCK)
- 3) MUST HAVE KILL SWITCH
- 4) FLY WHEEL PROTECTION
  - A. REQUIRED FOR OPEN CLASSES
  - B. HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR ALL OTHER CLASSES
- 5) WHEELIE BARS
  - A. REQUIRED FOR OPEN CLASSES
  - B. HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR ALL OTHER CLASSES
- 6) WHEEL WEIGHTS ONLY
  - A. REQUIRED IN STOCK CLASSES
- 7) ANYONE CAUSE TAMPERING WITH A TRACTOR OTHER THAN THEIR OWN WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM PULLING AND NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN
- 8) NO STEEL WHEELS
- 9) NO REVERSE TIRES
- 10) 10% OVER RPM'S ALLOWED – SEMI-STOCK
- 11) POINTS AND CONDENSER REPLACED BY EXCITER IGNITION - ALLOWED
- 12) NO MSD IGNITION OF AFTER-MARKET
- 13) ENGINE SPEED MUST BE CONTROLLED BY THROTTLE LEVER ONLY. NO STRINGS OR WIRES ALLOWED.
- 14) TRACTOR CAN PULL IN ANY GEAR, BUT NO SHIFTING OR USE OF TORQUE
- 15) MAXIMUM DRAWBAR HEIGHT IS 20" AT POINT OF HOOK. NO FAST HITCHES. MINIMUM OF 18" FROM CENTER OF AXEL TO HOOK. DRAWBAR MUST BE SOLID – NO MOVEMENT.
- 16) THE FRONT WEIGHT BRACKET CANNOT EXCEED 11' FROM THE CENTER OF THE REAR AXLE
- 17) FLAGMEN/TRACK OFFICIAL/ELIMINATOR CREW MAY STOP AND DISQUALIFY ANY PULLER FOR UNSAFE DRIVING OR EQUIPMENT AT ANY TIME, WITH NO MEASUREMENT. ALL DECISION ARE FINAL.
- 18) WHERE WEIGHTS FALL, IS THE MEASUREMENT OF THE PULL
- 19) ANYONE USING PROFANITY TOWARD TRACK OFFICIALS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- 20) ANYONE REFUSING TO WEIGHT TRACTOR BEFORE OR REWEIGHING AFTER A PULL WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- 21) EACH TRACTOR IS LIMITED TO ONE DRIVER PER CLASS, AND A MAX OF TWO HOOKS PER TRACTOR.
- 22) NO REPULL FOR FIRST DRIVER IN EACH CLASS.
- 23) A DRIVER MAY STOP TO ADJUST WEIGHTS PRIOR TO THE INITIAL SET OF CONES. HOWEVER, THEY MUST RESTART OF THEIR OWN POWER. LIMIT ONE RESTART.
- 24) ALL TRACTORS WILL BE INSPECTED AT WEIGH-IN TO ENSURE THESE RULES ARE MET.
